This term we will be investigating the question... What four countries form the UK?

<u>DT</u>

In D&T, we will investigate structures. We will look at a range of materials and explore why they stay in place and why they may not.

As part of maths we will be continuing to follow the Mastering Number programme which focuses on our mental math skills.

As scientists, we will be looking at animals including humans. Children will label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense. Pupils will also be identifying and naming a variety of common plants including trees. They will be looking at the basic structure of flowering plants naming the parts. They will also visit the local allotment to look and experience growing their own plants.

In PSHE, we will look at the importance of our physical health and wellbeing.

<u>Geography</u>

In Geography, will name, locate, and identify the four countries that make up the United Kingdom. Children will explore the globe further by identifying the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans.

RE

In RE, we are exploring the question What does it mean to belong to a faith community? Children will learn a range of symbols belonging to different faiths.

Music

In Music, children will be learning about rhythm and pulse. They will explore body percussion and move onto using a range of instruments.

Rationale

This topic has been chosen to enable children to gain an understanding of the world around us. They will expand on their knowledge of their local area to exploring the United Kingdom.

Children will develop their map skills so they can locate seas, oceans, and continents around the world.

English

In English, we will be using the story
'Lost and Found' to inspire our writing.
We will continue to use basic skills such
as capital letters, finger spaces and
full stops when building sentences. We
will also be extended our sentences
using conjunctions such as 'and'.
Children will have daily 'Read Write
Inc' phonic sessions where they will
learn a new sound each day. They will
practice reading these sounds in real
and nonsense words.



Phonics – children will be continuing to practice their phonic sounds and trying to improve their fluency. Please complete the phonics activities on Seesaw and daily reading.

Computing

In Computing, we will continue to look at how technology is used safely. Children will use I-Pads to create digital paintings. They will use different sizes and colours to make marks and drawings.
