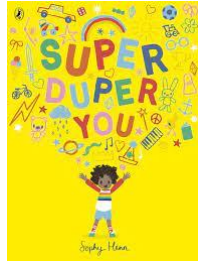


Sutton Park Primary Curriculum Map Reception Autumn One 2024 Super Me!

PE will be on Mondays. Please make sure all items of clothes are clearly named, even shoes and socks. We will also have a Forest School session on Monday afternoons. Your child will need a named pair of named wellies please.



Rationale - We have chosen this topic as it focuses on ourselves and what makes us SUPER. We will be discussing our likes and dislikes and what our talents are through using Superhero texts. We will also explore our feelings using the Colour Monster.

Physical Development

Our first challenge in our PE sessions will be to get dressed into our PE kits as independently as we can!! If your child could practise getting dressed at home too that would help their independence. We will practise skills such as running, skipping and hopping. We will be developing our fine motor skills by exploring with play dough, tweezers, scissors and much more.

Understanding of the World

We will be sharing photographs of ourselves as babies and looking at how we have changed over time. We will learn which foods are healthy and unhealthy and have a go at naming and sorting some fruits and vegetables.

Maths

This half term we will count different objects up to 10 and then beyond. We will have a go at matching the correct number of objects to the correct numeral. We will also be looking at numbers in our environment, what they are for and why they are there, e.g. on houses, on birthday cards or on buses.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will paint self-portraits to create a class gallery of masterpieces. Exploring with a variety of materials and tools will be lots of fun in our creative area this term.

What makes you SUPER?

Literacy

We will be sharing the story of 'Super Duper You' and using it as a discussion point about how we are all 'Super'. We will also share the 'Colour Monster' story to discuss how he felt when starting school. We will practise how to write our names using the Read, Write Inc. Letter formation rhymes. We will begin to learn individual letter sounds and have a go at writing them. We will send these home so you know which we are learning and when.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will share experiences and memories about ourselves and discussing our likes and dislikes. 'The Colour Monster' will help us to discuss and identify our feelings. We will also look at our baby photos to identify the changes that have occurred so far.

Communication and Language

Talking about ourselves will hopefully come naturally as we share our exciting stories about ourselves and what makes us special. We will be encouraging the children to talk about what makes them 'Super' and how they are unique.
