# Sutton Park Primary School Year One, Summer 1

## This term we will be investigating the question... **What can we find in the U.K?**



PE will be on Wednesdays and Fridays. Please make sure all your children's clothing are clearly labelled. If your child wears earrings, please make sure they take them out on PE days.

**KASE** Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our **KASE** curriculum.

## **English**

In English, we will be using two key texts, 'Katie in London' and 'Coming to England' to inspire our writing. Children will be writing postcards and letters, describing a range of famous landmarks in London. We will sequence the stories and create story maps to create our own stories. We will continue with daily Read Write Inc sessions to consolidate our phonic knowledge.

## **Science**

In science, we will be exploring the properties of everyday materials such as glass, metal and plastic. Children will complete an investigation to find out which materials are waterproof.

## **Art and DT**

In our Art lessons we will be finding out about the artist Anne Kelly. Children explore a range of materials, including fabric, oil crayons, chalk and paint, to create pieces of art. They will use natural and man-made fibres, combining colours and textures. In DT, we will explore the question can you build with bread? Children will look at a range of materials.

## **Maths**

We will introduce time and sequence events. We continue to develop our addition and subtraction skills using one- and two-digit numbers. We will also consolidate our understanding of 2D shapes. Children will begin to describe shapes using positional language and extend their mathematical vocabulary.

## **History**

This term we will be finding out what we can learn from the life and work of significant people. We will look at Neil Armstrong, Mae Jemison and Bernard Harris Jr, We will celebrate and compare their achievements.

## **Music**

Children will explore how music can create a range of emotions. They will use musical vocabulary to describe how different pieces of music makes them feel.

## **PE**

In PE, children will be developing their throwing skills in athletics. They will also practise their striking skills with a ball so that they improve their tennis skills.

## **Computing**

Children will gain understanding of the various aspects of using a computer. They will familiarise themselves with typing on a keyboard and begin using tools to change the look of their writing, and then they will consider the differences between using a computer and writing on paper to create text.

## **RE**

In RE, we will be building on skills already learnt about Judaism. Children will explore the question who is Jewish and how do they live?

## **PSHE and Thrive**

In these sessions, we will focus on 'me and others' Children will learn what makes themselves and others special. They will explore different responsibilities at home and school.
