

In the first half of the Autumn term, we learnt all about Ancient Greece. We are now going to combine this with new skills around grid references to find out more about the physical and human geography of Ancient Greece and how different places can be easily located.

English

In English, we are going to continue reading 'Who let the God's out?' and will use this to support our writing and our reading comprehension. We will begin by writing a set of instructions and exploring how different grammatical features can help us to do this effectively.

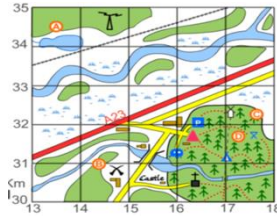
Following on from this, we will analyse and explore a range of non-chronological reports. This will give us the opportunity to write at length in non-fiction and continue to develop our knowledge of this genre of writing.

We will also continue our VIPERS sessions and our main focus will be on retrieving and summarising information.

Maths

In maths, we will begin by exploring multiplication and division, including factors and multiples as well as problem solving and reasoning. We will explore short and long multiplication and division, allowing children to find their preferred method and become fluent with them.

We will then move onto looking at fractions, with the focus on equivalence, ordering and comparing them. Finally, we will look at finding the area and perimeter of shapes, allowing the opportunity to put our knowledge of the four operations into practice.

This term we will consider the question...

What are grid references and how do they help us?

Geography

In geography, we will be learning about 4 and 6 figure grid references. We will investigate how to find them, why they are useful and how they can be used to provide more information about the human and physical geography of different places.

PSHE

We will be exploring how adverts influence people's behaviour and how fake information can feel real.

Thrive

Pupils will continue to explore strategies to improve self-esteem and self-confidence and how to be supportive of each other.

PE

In PE, we will be taking part in cross country and football. We will also be building on gymnastics from last half term and developing our bridges.

DT

In DT, we will be looking at our textiles skills and making decisions about which fabrics and stitches are most appropriate and fit for purpose.

PE will be on Tuesday and Wednesday.

We will be doing cross country and gymnastics.

RE

In RE, we will be looking at why Christians believe Jesus is the Messiah and how this affects special events like Christmas and Easter.

Art and Music

In music, we will be investigating stylistic features of pop music. We will then be writing, performing and analysing our own pop songs. In art, we will be focusing on print making and exploring which mediums are most appropriate to do this. We will be exploring the works of Warhol to support this.

Science

In science, we will be looking at the human timeline and how humans develop as they get older. We will also draw comparisons to the life of animals and explore similarities and differences.

Computing

In computing, we will be exploring how videos are filmed and edited. We will look at a range of filming techniques and film and edit our own videos to practice.
