## Curriculum Map Year 1

### Spring Term 2 2026

## How can we care for animals in our world?



**Rationale:** This topic will be an introduction to how we are responsible for looking after animals we share our planet with. Through this we can begin to connect hot and cold climates with natural and man-made features.

### **Maths**

In Maths, we will be deepening our knowledge on addition and subtraction within 50. Pupils will use a range of concrete, pictorial and abstract representations to help solve worded problems. Pupils will also focus on length and height using the associated vocabulary. Later in the term we will also learn about mass and volume in a range of practical contexts. Mastering number sessions will continue daily with a focus on number bonds, rapid recall of facts and application of these skills.

### **Science and Geography**

To become inquisitive scientists, this term we will revisit looking at animals including humans. To become geographers, this term we will be learning about hot and cold locations including human and physical features.

### **PSHE/ Thrive**

We will learn about what we put inside and onto our bodies. Pupils will explore how they make us feel and why we need these remedies to make us feel better.

### **Art**

This term we will learn to tear, cut and snip mediums. We will focus on artwork in the style of the artist Paul Klee.

### **Design and Technology**

We will be looking at different materials, and which are suitable or unsuitable for construction.

### **PE**

In outdoor games we will continue to practise our fundamental skills and use these in simple target games.

Our indoor sessions will focus on yoga and the flexibility in our muscles. This will also help our mental wellbeing.

### **Computing**

In our Computing lessons we will be introducing pupils to collecting data and information. They will focus on how to group and label information so that they can use computers to present their data.

### **RE**

Judaism will be our focus during RE sessions. We will learn about traditions, festivals and stories from the Jewish faith.

PE will be on Wednesdays and Thursdays.

Please make sure all your children's clothing are clearly labelled. If your child wears earrings, please make sure they take them out on PE days.

### **Music**

As musicians, pupils will begin to learn the difference between tempo and dynamics. They will explore how tempo and dynamics can be controlled through playing percussion instruments.

### **English**

During this term in our English, we will begin by looking at features of an information text and the difference between fiction and non-fiction. We will focus on finding out 'All about Hedgehogs' and we will write our own informative fact file.

Also, the class will be learning how to write instructions. We will begin with looking at how to follow instructions, which 'bossy' words we will need and how to order them using appropriate time words. This will lead to us writing our own set of instructions.

Daily phonic sessions will support our reading. Do look out for our weekly phonics home learning on Seesaw!
